

Cyber security course for physically-challenged

The Secur Eyes, a leading global cyber security specialised consulting services firm will start an on-line course on cyber security from May 15 for physically challenged candidates and retired people. The company will help the needy ones with financial support.

A research conducted by the International Information System Security Certification Consortium reveals that there is an estimated global shortage of nearly three million cyber security professionals as the digital economy is worth US\$11.5 trillion globally, equivalent to 15.5% of global GDP.
