Court serves notice to MLA Rameshwar

IMPHAL: The High Court of Manipur has served notice to ruling MLA Rameshwar Rameshwar for giving his response by May 20 on an application petition filed against him by an MLA. The notice of the petition was conducted in the court of Justice Lakshminarayanaiah and the court asked the respondent (Rameshwar) to file his response by May 20. In the petition, the MLA contended that MLA Rameshwar did not declare several informations regarding his involvement in public function and bank accounts in his election affidavit while joining the court to declare his eligibility for election to the 10th Manipal Leg-

islative assembly with 29 per cent margin of victory. Scungluchaba Devi Singh (BJP) from Heringang constituency won with 50 per cent margin of victory. Among the 40 winners, only five are women, with two have won with more than 50 per cent margin of victory. Among the women winners, 55 (BJP) from Chandel constituency won with the highest vote share, i.e., 79.06 per cent in her constituency. She won with a 34.32 per cent margin of victory. The analysis showed, Mizoram, out of total 35 re-elected winners, none have won with less than 25 per cent of vote share in their respective constituencies. NEW DELHI: After the resignation of Kamal Nath as leader of the opposition in the Madhya Pradesh Assembly, the Congress is gearing up to implement 'One Post One Man' role at the state level after the 'Chinman Mohir'. Several Congress leaders holding dual charge within the party in the state, sources said, adding that the party would be determined to be more vibrant in its performance and actively involve in political activities. The process will be gradual and more changes will be given an assignment at a time. Currently, Congress leaders like Ashwini Kumar Chaturvedi, Kamal Nath, and others are holding dual charge. Kamal Nath was holding the post of leader of opposition and state Congress President. Now he is only the chief of the state unit of the
